

Display Your Art at The Citizens Banks

Each Month, VAL members are given the opportunity to display one of their framed pieces of 2-dimensional art at one of three Citizens Banks. At the monthly meetings a drawing will be held during the meeting for an Artist to display their painting for the following month.

If you are interested in displaying your art in one of these banks, you can put your name in the basket of the bank where you wish to display when you come into the meeting. We will then draw the lucky name from those in the basket. (Note: Paintings have sold from these banks; the customer will call you and you will transact the sale. The bank does not get involved. You can replace that painting with another for the remainder of the month.)

- The painting can be up to 18" wide x 24" high*
- The artist must attach a completed VAL Business Card - found on the VAL website.*
- The artist chosen for each bank will bring their painting to the designated bank on the first working day of the month and set it on the easel that is provided.*
- The artist must remove their picture on the last working day of the month so the easel is empty and ready for the next artist's picture.*
