VAL Fall Extravaganza – Rules

- **Registration dates are:**
 - **Priority Registration: 9/17/2018** (Those who have volunteered in the last 2 years.)
 - **General Membership: 9/24/2018**
 - **Registration close 10/12/2018** (In order to get the program printed with participants names.) Submissions mailed prior to these dates will not be accepted. If spaces fill prior to 10/12/2018, you will be notified and put on a waiting list.)
- **Registration fee:** \$20.00
- The Artist must be a member of the VAL in good standing (Membership is current and attends meetings.)
- Each artist must apply as an individual: One registration form in one envelope.

This is a 2D and 3D show. Work must be:

- Artist's own creation
 - No political, religious or nudity is allowed
 - 2D art work must be matted in clear cellophane envelopes and/or framed, Canvas paintings do not have to be framed.
 - 3D art is limited to art that is designed by the artist using raw materials that have been made into an art object. (Examples: clay made into art objects; jewelry that is made from gems, stone, glass, wire that has been cut polished and put in the setting made by the artist and not manufactured. Wood that has been sculpted/carved into sculpture etc.)
 - Jewelry that is made from craft stores materials & online craft sites, such as plastic or wooden beads, trinkets etc. ribbon or fabric are considered craft items and are not allowed.
 - Craft items are not allowed.
 - Each piece of art must be labeled using the VAL business card (found on the website). Clearly showing the title, artist's name, medium (including whether it is original/print/giclee) and price. (DISCOUNT OR CLEARANCE SIGNS ARE NOT ALLOWED.)
 - 2D & 3D art prices must be clearly marked.
 - Showcasing or displaying of previously won ribbons/awards is not allowed.
 - NO Manufactured goods are allowed. Violation is grounds for expulsion.
- Artist's spaces will be allotted according to the USPO date stamp.
 - 7:00AM - Doors open for set up.
 - 8:30AM – Artist must be ready for show.
 - 9:00AM – Show opens to public (Note: They will probably show up early.)
 - 3:00PM – Show closes at 3:00 and artists are NOT ALLOWED TO BREAK DOWN until then. (Early breakdown may disqualify an artist from future shows.)
 - Parking – after unloading, move your vehicle to pool side of building or further out in the parking lot to allow for visitors and patrons to park closer.
 - Each space is 12' x 5' and can be set up with 2 - 6' tables; 1 - 6' table and 6' open space; or 12' open space with 1 or 2 chairs.
 - Tables must be covered to the floor on all sides to conceal items under your table.
 - Packing materials must be out of sight or taken to your vehicle. **AISLES CANNOT BE BLOCKED.**
 - Artists may NOT trade spaces with another artist. (Violation can result in expulsion.)
 - Tables cannot be moved – this is a liability issue.
 - You must stay within your allotted space and not encroach on another artist's space.

REMEMBER TO WEAR YOUR VAL MEMBERSHIP NAME TAG AND HAVE A WONDERFUL SHOW.
