Artist of the Month—Alexander "Sandy" Turnbull




Alexander "Sandy" Turnbull is considered a "painterly artist" who portrays his subjects using vibrant color, expressive strokes and a respect for good composition. Over the past 10 years, his medium of choice is pastels, using them for commissioned portraits of people, animals and landscapes.

He is an artist now living in The Villages, Florida with his wife of 46 years. He was born and raised in Tampa, Florida. After graduation from college and service in the U.S. Air Force, he worked as a mechanical design engineer, which included design of mechanical systems in commercial buildings. He has also produced archi-

tectural renderings for contractors and a real estate developer.

Throughout his forty plus working years, he improved his artistic skills in classroom studios, personal studies, and numerous workshops. He has taught art for a retail commercial art supply company and has given painting demonstrations and art lessons.

Currently he is a member of the Village Art Association, the Village Art League and the Central Florida Pastel Society.


April Program—Margie Picard

Margie Picard has never had any formal art training and most of her creations come from the fact that she has been given this gift of art. She loves to create and has always done some form of artwork throughout her life. All through school she took every art class she was allowed to take, tried any new craft she found and just enjoyed creating. In the 1990s while working for the State of Connecticut she took a watercolor class and fell in love with the medium. After moving to The Villages and taking a silk painting class with Sherrill Schoening through the Lifelong Learning College, she discovered that silk painting is very similar to watercolor in that it flows and sometimes does its own thing. Inspired by this, but not in love with the steaming of the dyes that were used in the class, she researched and found the Dye-na-Flow paints. They react like the silk dyes but do not require the steaming method and can be set with a regular iron. The colors are not quite as intense as the dyes but, as she loves things that are fast and simple, this product fit her needs. She teaches a class at **All About Art** in Belleview on creating silk



scarves the easy way, and when you leave the class you have 2 beautiful hand painted silk scarves that you have created.

Margie is very honored to have the opportunity to demonstrate this fun process for the VAL members.
