Artist of the Month—George Freeman



About sixteen years ago I took an introduction to flameworking course offered by an adult education class in the Boston area. Flameworking, sometimes called lampworking, is melting and manipulating glass rods in the flame of a torch. Shortly after taking that course, we moved to The Villages and I added an extra five feet onto the garage so I could set up my own glass shop. I started by making glass beads, pendants and rings. Several years ago I met Dave Sandidge who was a glass artist at Disney. I've taken a few lessons from him and I've been working on glass sculptures ever since.



Many of my sculptures are marine life, most likely influenced by growing up near the ocean and many years of scuba diving. Inspired by nature, I also sculpt flowers and birds. Last year I had one of my pieces featured in

The Flow, a magazine for glass artists. I love the way glass moves when in a fluid state. When I'm out in the garage working on my glass, I feel like I'm in a Zen moment and

Arrachme is comfortable working across many mediums and is skillful in combining them to create her fine art which is consistently published and exhibited in museums internationally. She is regularly invited to participate in collaborations worldwide that exhibit her contemporary abstract paintings for which her passions are humanitarian, social and environmental causes. As an art educator, lecturer and judge, she enjoys breaking down otherwise difficult concepts into easily understandable processes.



Arrachme will demonstrate and give an overview of how to use cold wax medium crossing from acrylics to oils. While applying layers, she teaches

how a student can continuously critique their own artwork using a built-up knowledge base. This reveals adjustments, using both left and right brain activity in order to achieve a final beautiful painting.
