## VAL SUMMER ART FESTIVAL – Rules

- Registration dates are: Registration: June 8<sup>th</sup> General Membership (forms will be on VAL website). Registrations must be RECEIVED on or before June 18<sup>th</sup>, 2021 (In order to get the program printed with participants names. If spaces fill prior to June 18<sup>th</sup>, you will be notified and put on a waiting list).
- Registration fee is \$25.00
- This is a 2 dimensional and 3-dimensional show.
- All Current members are eligible to participate as an exhibitor in this event IF DUES ARE PAID.
- Participants must be members for 3 months prior to June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021 (March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021).
  - All forms of art may be exhibited, BUT NO CRAFTS
  - Only one artist per table
  - New members that wish to participate, will be put on a waiting list.
  - Work must be Artists own creation.
  - VAL display cards are on the web site for use to describe & price your art.
- Each artist must apply as an individual: One registration form in one envelope.
- Artist's spaces will be allotted according to the USPO date stamp.

FRIDAY NIGHT SET UP IS FROM 6:30PM TO 8:30PM.

SATURDAY MORNING SET UP IS FROM 7AM to 8:30AM. Artist must be ready for show at 8:30AM.

- 7:00AM - Doors open for set up.
- 8:30AM – Artist must be ready for show.
- 9:00AM – Show opens to public (Note: They will probably show up early).
- 3:00PM – Show closes at 3:00 and artists are NOT ALLOWED TO BREAK DOWN until then. (Early breakdown may disqualify an artist from future shows).
- Parking – after unloading, move your vehicle to pool side of building or further out in the parking lot to allow for visitors and patrons to park closer.
- Each space is 12' x 5' and can be set up with 2 - 6' tables; 1 - 6' table and 6' open space; or 12' open space with 1 or 2 chairs.
- Tables must be covered to the floor on all sides to conceal items under your table.
- Packing materials must be out of sight or taken to your vehicle. **AISLES CANNOT BE BLOCKED.**
- Artists may NOT trade spaces with another artist. (Violation can result in expulsion).
- Tables cannot be moved – this is a liability issue.
- You must stay within your allotted space and not encroach on another artist's space.
- 2D art work must be matted in clear cellophane envelopes and/or framed. Canvas paintings do not have to be framed.
- 3D art is limited to art that is designed by the artist using raw materials that have been made into an art object. (Examples: clay made into art objects, jewelry that is made from gems, stone, glass, and wire that has been cut polished and put in the setting made by the artist and not manufactured. Wood

that has been sculpted/carved into sculpture, etc.). Jewelry that is made from manufactured craft materials from stores and online craft sites, such as plastic or wooden beads, trinkets, etc. ribbon or fabric are considered craft items and are not allowed.
