Rules & Regulations for the Eisenhower Exhibit

1. All art must be original two-dimensional fine art paintings in the following categories: Oil, Acrylic, Watercolor, Pen & Ink, Colored Pencil, Pastel, Graphite, and Charcoal. If you are not sure your painting Qualifies, please call the Chair Person.
2. Because of limited space, artwork must be 16 x 20 or smaller.
3. Each artist may display only one piece of art.
4. No reproductions of other artist's work from workshops etc.; published photos; prints or giclee's will be accepted.
5. The artwork must be framed or gallery wrapped, wired, clean and in good condition with bumpers on the corners to protect the walls. No saw tooth hangers.
6. Artist's name and telephone number must appear on back of each painting.
7. Each painting should have the title card on the front.
8. Work is to remain for entire length of the show. Work may be exhibited one time only at this venue. Exhibit Committee Chairman reserves the right to decline an entry into the show due to failure to follow the state rules.
9. If your art work is sold, please call the chairman of the show before removing your painting. You will be allowed to replace it with a painting of similar size. We will need to update your paperwork. Thank you for your cooperation.
