VAL Fall Fine Art Show – Rules

- Registration dates are:
 - ▶ Priority Registration: 9/13/2024
 - ▶ General Membership: 9/20/2024
 - ▶ Registration closes 10/11/2024 (In order to get the program printed with participants names.) Submissions mailed prior to these dates will not be accepted. If spaces fill prior to 10/11/2023, you will be notified and put on a waiting list.
 - Registration fee: \$25.00 NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER 10/23/24
 - The Artist must be a member of the VAL in good standing (Membership dues current and have attended at least 3 meetings.)
 - Each artist must apply as an individual, only one artist per space allowed.
 - Participants must be members for a minimum of 3 months prior to the show.
 - ▶ Only items listed on Page 1 can be exhibited/sold. You must circle the medium(s) you will be exhibiting/selling. NO CRAFTS ALLOWED
 - ▶ New members that have not attended 3 meetings and wish to participate will be put on a waiting list.
 - ▶ Work must be Artists own creation.
 - ▶ VAL display cards are on the web site for use to describe & price your art. Clearance, sale and/or markdowns are not allowed, please price your art accordingly.
 - Artist's spaces will be allotted according to the USPO date stamp.
 - This is a 2 dimensional and 3-dimensional show as described below:
 - 2D artwork must be matted in clear cellophane envelopes and/or framed, Canvas paintings do not have to be framed.
 - 3D art is limited to art that is designed by the artist using raw materials that have been made into an art object. (Examples: clay made into art objects; jewelry that is made from gems, stone, glass, wire that has been cut polished and put in the setting made by the artist and not manufactured. Wood that has been sculpted/carved into sculpture etc.) 3D pieces made from manufactured craft materials from stores & online craft sites, such as plastic or wooden beads, shells, trinkets etc. ribbon or fabric are considered craft items and are not allowed.
 - Friday Night set up 5:30 PM
 - Saturday Morning set up is from 7:00 AM to 8:30 AM Artist Must be Ready for show at 8:30 AM
 - 9:00AM – Show opens to public (Note: They will probably show up early.)
 - 3:00PM – Show closes at 3:00 and artists are NOT ALLOWED TO BREAK DOWN PRIOR TO 3:00. (Early breakdown may disqualify an artist from future shows.)
 - Parking – after unloading, move your vehicle to the pool side of the building or further out in the parking lot to allow visitors and patrons to park closer.
 - Each space is 12' x 5' and can be set up with 2 - 6' tables; 1 - 6' table and 6' open space; or 12' open space with 1 or 2 chairs. Artists may NOT trade spaces with another artist. (Violation can result in expulsion.) You must stay within your allotted space and not encroach on another artist's space, exit, doorway,....
 - Tables must be covered to the floor on all sides to conceal items under your table.
 - Packing materials must be out of sight or taken to your vehicle. AISLES AND DOORS CANNOT BE BLOCKED.
 - Tables cannot be moved – this is a liability issue.
